White Wine

Castillo del Moro Sauvignon Blanc/Airen, Spain, 12%

Crisp, fruity white with a twist of citrus to accompany the fresh, green fruit

Villa Wolf, Pinot Gris, Germany 12%

Juicy, full and medium bodied, a slight sweetness and a light citrus herbaceous aroma

Mont Rocher Viognier, France, 13%

Honeysuckle and apricot aroma with a rich palate that is somehow still dry

The Dot Pepper Gruner Veltliner, Austria, 12.5%

Clean-cut green apple, spiked with white pepper. Textbook young Gruner

Toscana Bianco Sangiovese, Saragnano, Italy, 12.5%

Rich in taste and minerality, pleasantly fresh, harmonious and slightly savoury, it closes with a distinctively floral finish

Terre d'Eole, Picpoul de Pinet, France, 13%

A perfect wine for a Summer's day; bone dry and refreshing with flavours of lemons, apples and a hint of almonds. Excellent Pinot Grigio alternative

El Coto Rioja Blanco, Spain, 12%

Pale lemon in colour with bright aromas of peaches, apples and tropical fruit

Nosiola, Cantina Lavis, Italy, 12%

Pale yellow in colour with pastel green tints, it exudes rose petals, lychee and jasmine

Snapper Rock Sauvignon Blanc, Snapper Rock, NZ, 13%

Strong passionfruit, red capsicum, gooseberry and wild herb flavours. Mouth-watering acidity leaves the palate fresh and dry

Sand Boy Albarino, Spain, 13%

Freshly cut grass and citrus fruit on the nose lead to lush acidity with ripe, juicy stone fruit character with a touch of spice

Red Wine

Castillo del Moro Tempranillo Syrah, Spain, 13%

Silky smooth with ripe dark fruit with a touch of spice, and a soft, juicy finish

La Barbe Merlot, France, 14%

Highly drinkable, luscious, spicy, fruity, plummy and smooth unoaked blend

Santuario Malbec, Argentina, 14%

Plum, blueberry and blackcurrant with plenty of complexity and a harmonious finish

Tinazzi Duca delle Corone Primitivo, Italy, 14%

Rich, deeply coloured with notes of plum and morello cherry on the nose

Villa Wolf Pinot Noir, J L Wolf, Germany, 12.5%

Warm and medium-bodied with forward, dark cherry fruit, a firm structure and a spicy mid-palate. Smoky depth and earthy tannins.

The Heilan Coo Shiraz Mataro, Australia, 14%

85% Shiraz, blended with 15% Mataro. Super juicy, smooth and silky with ripe red berry fruit flavours balanced by sweet spicy clove and black pepper flavours

Sossego Alentejo Tinto, Portugal, 14%

This wine is bright ruby red in colour. On the nose, generous aromas of strawberries and red cherries stand out, with spicy complexity coming from the oak ageing

Cerro Anon Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Olarra, Spain, 13.5%

A blend of Tempraillo, Mazuelo, Graciano and Garnacha. This wine is fruity and spicy with good structure, soft tannins and lovely balance

The Dot Austrian Cherry Zweigelt, Pfaffl, Austria, 13.5%

Fabulously bright, fire-engine-red cherry fruit. Bite and crunch with deep tannins.

Domaine de l'Espigouette Cotes du Rhone, France,

Full flavoured Côtes du Rhône with bright red fruit, good weight, some spice and pepper

Rosé Wine

St. Felix Rose, Domaine Les Yeuses, France, 12.5%

A light, fruity and dry rosé produced from a blend of Grenache and Cinsault grapes

Benguela Cove Lighthouse Rose, South Africa, 13%

This rosé shows juicy watermelon, candyfloss and red berry fruit with a floral bouquet

Clos Maguise Provence Rosé, France, 13%

Pale pink in complexion. On the nose there are aromas of raspberry, strawberry, cranberry and redcurrant. The palate is crisp red fruit with a hint of minerality.
